



Total Cost of Attendance 2026-2027

In order to establish compliance with the PA Act 69 of 2024, Moore College of Art & Design has published this document which includes a history of the previous academic year tuition and an estimated total cost of attendance for all academic years necessary to complete the degree or credential. We estimated the future years' cost of attendance by using the current years' costs. We cannot predict the change in cost of attendance in advance.

Definition of Cost of Attendance

A student's cost of attendance (COA), or financial aid budget, is the sum of all direct and indirect costs associated with the student attending a degree or credential-seeking program in an academic year.

Direct costs are payable to the college such as tuition & fees, and room & meal charges for residential students. Indirect costs include estimates for things we believe students may need in order to be able to complete their degree requirements such as books & supplies, a computer, personal & miscellaneous expenses, federal loan fees, and transportation to and from campus. Expenses related to the cost of obtaining their first professional credential, dependent care, disability-related costs, study abroad costs are added to the standard COA when applicable.

Certain indirect costs are prorated for students who are less than full time but at least half time. These costs include; books & supplies and transportation.

Certain indirect costs are not included for students who are less than half time. These costs include; food & housing, federal loan fees, and personal & miscellaneous expenses.

Student Health Insurance is an annual fee charged in the first semester of enrollment for each year which can be waived by a reasonable deadline for students who have proof of appropriate health insurance coverage. It can be added to the COA upon request if the student cannot waive the fee.

Each year the Director of Financial Aid is responsible for reviewing information from the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Expenditure Survey (CES), USDA Food and Nutrition Service, and a bi-annual student survey which is completed in the fall term of odd years to determine the amounts for food and housing for off-campus and commuter students.
