Moore College of Art & Design is committed to providing a supportive, inclusive and equitable campus environment for all Moore students. Traveling to campus every day? We have loads of resources for commuter students so you'll always feel supported and at home, whether you're on or off campus.

CURRENT COMMUTER STUDENT RESOURCES:

Resource Pantry

Students are welcome to drop by our Student Affairs Resource Pantry, located on the 1st floor of Stahl Hall, weekdays from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. The Resource Pantry offers non-perishable food, personal care items, school supplies, art supplies, clothes and printed and online resources for Moore students who are in need of assistance.

Aftermath Emergency Fund

This fund is intended to be a supplemental financial resource for students who are experiencing unexpected emergency expenses that directly impact or jeopardize continued enrollment at Moore. Students are eligible for emergency funding up to \$500 per academic year and applications for funding will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority is given to students who demonstrate severe financial hardship due to an emergency or unanticipated circumstance.

Transportation Assistance Request Form

Commuter students can complete a Transportation Assistance Request Form to receive free transit passes to commute in Philadelphia via bus, trolley, subway or Norristown High Speed Line. Applications for transportation assistance are accepted on a rolling basis. Amount of assistance given is based on availability of funds. Applications for funding will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis and priority is given to commuter students and students who demonstrate financial need.

Meal Voucher Request Form

Students who do not have a meal plan can complete a Meal Voucher Request Form to receive free meal vouchers through Moore's dining services. Applications to receive meal vouchers are accepted on a rolling basis. Amount of assistance given is based on availability of funds. Applications for funding will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority is given to students who do not have a meal plan and demonstrate financial need.

Moore Shuttle

Students can ride the Moore shuttle each night during the fall and spring semesters. The route passes through local spots including: Suburban Station, City Hall, the Fashion District, Chinatown and South Street.
