

Honor Code for Safety and Release

Moore College of Art and Design (the "College") seeks to ensure the safest environment possible for the welfare of the entire community ("Moore Community"). During these unprecedented times, we have needed to make some changes in order to maintain the wellbeing for all community members. Therefore, as a member of the Moore Community, I recognize the importance of the guidelines listed below and will adhere to the following:

- I will always wear my face covering while I am on campus. The only exceptions are when alone in my own private office, alone in my shared office, or when lecturing at a podium that is 12 feet away from the nearest student.
- For my own personal safety and the safety of our students, I will only eat in my private office or when alone in my shared office. Faculty who do not have an office space may utilize an empty classroom. I recognize that Dining Hall and auxiliary dining spaces will be reserved for student use only.
- If I feel sick or am showing symptoms, I will remain at home and contact my immediate supervisor and the Director of Human Resources. Common symptoms are a fever over 100.4 F, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing*, sore throat, muscle pain, headache, and new loss of taste and/or smell. *I understand the importance of seeking medical care if I, or someone I know, have emergency warning signs of COVID-19 (trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, inability to wake or stay awake, or bluish lips or face).
- I agree to check my own temperature daily and will be prepared to have my temperature checked at the front door of campus to ensure that I am in good health.
- I will follow all social distancing guidelines and any new guideline published or posted by the College. These guidelines include staying 6 feet apart from each other, when possible. For common areas I will follow the posted signs of how many people are allowed in the space.
- I promise to limit social interaction off campus and to follow safe social distancing and face covering practices when leaving the College campus to exercise, etc. in order to maintain the safety of my peers at Moore and members of the Moore Community.
- If you must take public transportation, wear a mask before entering public transportation and avoid touching surfaces. Upon disembarking, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol as soon as possible and before removing your mask.
- If I learn that I have come in contact or have contracted Covid-19, I will contact my immediate supervisor and Director of Human Resources. I will be prepared to provide information of who I may have been in physical contact with from the Moore Community.
