

Honor Code for Safety and Release

Moore College of Art & Design seeks to ensure the safest environment possible for the welfare of the entire community. Given the unprecedented circumstances brought on by COVID-19, the College has and will continue to invest a significant amount of resources in order to maintain a clean and safe learning and residential environment for students during the Spring 2021 semester, following up-to-date recommendations and guidelines from the CDC, the Pennsylvania Department of Health and City of Philadelphia Department of Public Health. We have made changes in order to maintain the wellbeing of all community members, and we ask that our students, faculty and staff do the same by signing this Honor Code prior to their return or welcome to our campus this fall.

Therefore, as a member of the Moore community, I recognize the importance of the guidelines listed below and will adhere to the following:

- During the 14-day period prior to my arrival on campus, I agree to:
 - o Adhere to social distancing guidelines, including keeping a 6-foot separation from others and wearing my face covering or mask when outside my residence.
 - o I will avoid large indoor and outdoor gatherings whenever possible.
 - o I will limit my interactions with people outside of the members of my immediate household.
 - o If I or another member of my household contracts COVID-19, I will inform Student Health Services.
- I will always wear my face covering or mask while I am on campus. The only exceptions are when eating or my own bedroom or utilizing the bathroom for showering, bathing and brushing teeth.
- If I feel that I am sick I will remain at home and contact the appropriate individuals (professors, Nurse, Student Health Services). Symptoms to be aware of are a fever over 100.4 F, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste and/or smell.
- I agree to check my own temperature daily and will be prepared to have my temperature checked at the front door of campus to ensure that I am in good health.
- I will follow all social distancing guidelines. These guidelines are always to stay 6 feet apart from each other, when possible. For common areas I will follow the posted signs of how many people are allowed in the space.
- If I am a Commuter Student, I realize that I will not be permitted to enter the Residence Halls.
- If I am a Residential Student, I understand that I will only have access to the residence hall that I reside in.
- I promise to limit social interaction off campus and to follow safe social distancing and face-covering practices when leaving the College to exercise, etc. in order to maintain the safety of my peers at Moore.
- If I must take public transportation, I will wear a mask before entering public transportation and avoid touching surfaces. Upon disembarking, I will wash my hands or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol as soon as possible and before removing my mask.
- If I learn that I have come in contact or have contracted Covid-19, I will contact the Nurse immediately. I will be prepared to provide information of who I may have been in physical contact with from the Moore Community.
